MEDICAL (M-S) AND PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT STUDENTS (PA-S)

1. Medical-S, and PA-S will be expected to learn and perform a focused medical history, do an appropriate physical exam, make gram stain and interpret the microscopic results, mount a wet prep and interpret the microscopic results, and do a short contact interview. They will then give the supervising care provider their findings and recommended treatment plan in accordance with clinic protocols and procedures.
2. They may also perform:
  - a. IM injections of medicines.
  - b. Administration of P.O. medications.
  - c. Topical application of some medications.
3. The EDC staff health care provider will countersign all medical documentation.
