

Family Medicine Residency Clinic

Home to over 12,000 Soldiers, retirees and their family members, the residency clinic supports four primary care teams. Our clinic contains 40+ exam rooms, procedure suites, and clinician offices. We provide limited obstetrical ultrasound, cardiac stress testing, immunizations, osteopathic manipulation, minor procedures, integrated Behavioral Health counseling, nursing case management and pharmacology consultation. We are a certified NCQA Level III Patient Centered Medical Home.
