

IVF Information

IVF is not a Tricare covered benefit and the patient is responsible for paying out of pocket for **andrology** and **embryology** expenses during IVF. Please see the Tricare website at <http://www.tricare.mil/mybenefit> for more information on Tricare benefits and infertility coverage.

Currently Tricare does not cover costs of sperm preparation, oocyte (egg) manipulation, or embryos. Intrauterine insemination and In Vitro Fertilization costs will be the responsibility of the patient.

IVF is offered 4 times a year and patients are placed on a wait list for an average of 6-12 months. Please contact the IVF coordinator, at **910-643-2589** for more information.

IVF Pre-testing (Female)

- Prior to the start of the IVF cycle, all testing (male and female) must be completed and be less than one year old. Failure to complete required testing will result in cycle being postponed until such time that it is completed. As per our referral guidelines, patients with a BMI > 35 will not be accepted into program.

We prefer that all testing be completed at WAMC through our clinic, but if you are unable to do the testing at our facility, and prefer to have a provider at another location perform the testing, you must have all results faxed to the IVF coordinator at (910)907-7825.
