

A Healthy Plate

The goal of building a healthy plate is to show how eating a variety of foods will help you feel satisfied, help control blood sugar levels and control weight. Add a small amount of margarine or oil in cooking or at the table.




Choose 1 serving of milk which is 8 ounces.




Add 1 serving of fruit.

Fill 1/4 of your plate with a starchy choice such as 1/2 cup mashed potatoes.



Fill 1/4 of your plate with lean meat, chicken or fish; this is about 3 ounces.



1/2 of your plate with vegetables such as broccoli, carrots, cauliflower, and salad.



For breakfast, use only half the plate.



For lunch and dinner, use the whole plate.
