

EFMP Over Seas Screening Appointments

Service Member and Family Members:

You are making an appointment for an Over Seas Accompanied Tour Medical Screening. It is essential that you **arrive 15 minutes early** to complete the DA Form 7246 and Ages and Stages child development questionnaires **prior** to your appointment time. For any questions to which you answer yes, we will review those and your medical history to determine if you meet criteria for enrollment in EFMP before stamping/signing the DA Form 5888. The DA Form 5888, once stamped/signed will need to be returned to Levy at the Soldier Support Center after your appointment. The Levy Section at the Soldier Support Center then processes your paperwork.

For your appointment with EFMP, 5th Floor Womack, you will need to bring:

1. A current (*within the last 12 months*) comprehensive Health Assessment (well child, well woman, or annual physical) for **each** traveling family member
2. Copies of ALL medical records from civilian or non-military medical treatment facilities
3. All children who have not yet entered kindergarten, and Family Members ages 18 and over who will be added to your orders
4. If applicable: DD Form 2792, completed by your medical provider prior to your appointment with EFMP **if** there are any conditions *which might* warrant EFMP medical enrollment or updates, for example, Family Members who:
 - REQUIRE treatment by a specialist (to include pediatricians and internists)
 - Have a serious, life threatening condition
 - Have been treated for a mental health condition within the past 5 years(There is a list of EFMP enrollable conditions at the EFMP reception desk – please review this list to determine if you may need a DD Form 2792)
5. If applicable: IEP/IFSP/504 Plan, and DD Form 2792 - 1 completed by your child's school or Early Intervention Program, for educational enrollments

Please allow yourself extra time to find a parking space.

What can you expect during your appointment?

1. A nurse will review your medical information, DA Form 7246, current Health Assessment and past medical history, identify any specialty services you need, review all DD Forms 2792/2792-1 and Educational or Early Intervention Plans.
2. Nurse will either a) request additional documentation from you or b) stamp and sign your DA Form 5888 indicating whether Family Members do or do not require EFMP enrollment.
