

Directions

Fort Bragg is a secure military post. All military with a valid identification card may access the post from all entrances. Civilians with a valid state (any state) license, are authorized access to Fort Bragg. Non-military members should expect to have their vehicles searched. To speed the process, please empty your vehicle of excess items.

From Fayetteville

Option 1:

All American Expressway North to Fayetteville.

Exit Reilly Road (stop to show ID).

Cross Normandy.

Left into Womack Army Medical Center parking lot.

All parking areas are authorized for visitors and patients.

Option 2:

All American Expressway North to Fayetteville.

Show ID at Check Point.

Cross Zabitosky and Normandy.

Turn right into Womack Army Medical Center parking lot.

All parking areas are authorized for visitors and patients.

From Points North of Fayetteville

Option 1:

Route 1 South to Sanford (do not take Business 1)

Left (East) Hwy 78 (at traffic light). Landmark: Hardie's on Left

Right (South) Hwy 421/87). Landmark: McDonald's on Right

Bear right on Hwy 87 to Fayetteville.

Hwy 87 becomes Bragg Blvd once at Fort Bragg.

Right on Randolph Rd. This is the inspection station. Follow signs to the "No-Decal" lane if you do not have valid military identification.

Right on Knox Street (2nd light).

Left on McComb Street (1st Light)

Left on Reilly Rd (T-Intersection)

Right into hospital entrance.

Option 2:

US 40 East to US 95 South, Follow directions from the section "From US 95"

From Points West of Fayetteville

Option 1: (shorter for Charlotte and North of Charlotte)

Hwy 74 East (Independence Blvd.) (For Folks North of Charlotte consider 52 East to Albemarle)

Left on Hwy 24/27 (Albemarle Rd) towards Albemarle.

In Albemarle, 24/27 turns Right after Tacobell.

In Troy 24/27 bears right at gas station.

In Carthage, 24/27 joins 501, then turns Right (East).

Hwy 27 splits from 24. Take Hwy 24 South towards Fayetteville and Fort Bragg.

Right on Hwy 24/87 Fayetteville and Fort Bragg.
Hwy 87 becomes Bragg Blvd once at Fort Bragg.
Right on Randolph Rd. This is the inspection station. Follow signs to the “No-Decal” lane.
Right on Knox Street (2nd light).
Left on McComb Street (1st Light)
Left on Reilly Rd (T-Intersection)
Right into hospital entrance.

Option 2: (Shorter for South East of Charlotte)

Hwy 74 East through Monroe, Wadesboro, Rockingham, Hamlet and Laurinburg.
In Laurinburg, Hwy 401 North/East through Silver City to Fayetteville.
Take the All American Freeway (Left at Light) North.
Exit Sante Fe, bear right at Exit.
Left on Bragg Blvd.
Left on Randolph. This is the inspection station. Follow signs to the “No-Decal” lane.
Right on Knox Street (2nd light).
Left on McComb Street (1st Light)
Left on Reilly Rd (T-Intersection)
Right into hospital entrance.

From Points Along US 95

US 95 towards Fayetteville.
Exit Fayetteville / Hwy 24 West.
Hwy 24 joins 210/ 87. Bears right at the bottom of the 401 By-pass bridge.
Hwy 24/87/210 becomes Bragg Blvd.
Left on Randolph. This is the inspection station. Follow signs to the “No-Decal” lane.
Right on Knox Street (2nd light).
Left on McComb Street (1st Light)
Left on Reilly Rd (T-Intersection)
Right into hospital entrance.
